

SUBWAY RESTAURANT ROLLA, MISSOURI



The owner approached Integrity Engineering and requested that we design a very unique and attractive structure to house his subway business. The site also had several constraints including encroachment upon a 100 year flood plain and a very unusual triangular shape.

Integrity met the owners expectations by completing a wood framed brick and faux stone veneered building which seats 55 customers and is constructed for long term ownership with low maintenance. The site was constructed to allow for a future car wash on the site as a second phase. The building includes high efficiency heating and cooling and a TPO roof that is warranted for 20 years.
